
HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

The *Clinical Handbook of Psychotropic Drugs* uses color coding and icons for intuitive navigation:

- Blue sections contain general information on drugs / treatments and their availability.
- Green sections cover drug action and dosing.
- Red sections outline warnings and precautions.
- Orange sections detail patient- and care-related information, such as nursing considerations and patient advice.
